

Graduate Accommodation
Snow and ice clearing policy

Introduction

The Graduate Accommodation Office is committed to providing safe environment for all residents.

In order to maintain a safe environment there are a number of arrangements in place to deal with ice and snow during the winter months.

Gritting

If weather temperatures are due to drop to zero or below, Site Assistants will aim to grit pathways within the grounds of the student residences where required i.e. steps, sloped areas and footpaths outside the immediate vicinity of a student residence.

Priority clearance routes for pedestrian and vehicle access have been identified and are detailed on maps held by the Graduate Accommodation Office.

Site Assistants will review the conditions during the day and supplement the laying of grit as problems present themselves during the working day (week days only).

The weather forecast is monitored via the Met Office or the Highways Agency and when frost or snow is predicted the night before, Site Assistants will lay down grit as detailed above before 3pm.

Snow and Ice Clearance

During the working day (week days only) and where reasonably possible Site Assistants will clear snow to enable safe entrance to buildings.

In the event of severe weather conditions, the Site Managers and Graduate Accommodation Manager will supply the Site Assistants with regular updates to allow timely decisions to be made concerning the limiting or closing of any services or facilities. The Graduate Accommodation Manager will then communicate this to all residents. The residents will be expected to follow any advice given, and act sensibly.

Out of Hours

For out of hours (in particular during the Christmas closed period) Security Services will contact NGS to arrange gritting and snow clearance in accordance with the defined priority clearance routes.

Local Authorities Responsibilities



The following areas will be gritted by NGS between midnight and 6am if the weather is predicted to hit a temperature of zero or below.


- Summertown House (Map Appendix 1)

- Castle Mill (Map Appendix 4)


Appendix 1 - Summertown House
